

When Was Your Home Built?

We need to know.

- A new rule by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires all renovation and repair contractors working in homes built before 1978 to be EPA Certified in lead-safe work practices.
- KSI Kitchen & Bath and our installers are in full compliance with the EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule, and are all Lead-Safe Certified.
- The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency created the new rule to protect people's health, especially children.
- New research shows that contractors like carpenters, plumbers, electricians, painters and window replacement experts can inadvertently expose children and adults to harmful levels of lead from invisible dust disturbed during jobs they perform every day.
- It's very important, the EPA says, that contractors learn how to work lead-safe and that families hire lead-safe certified contractors.
